

Dear St. Margaret Mary Family Member,

Stewardship is at its core an attitude of gratitude for God's blessings in creating us with our own talents and abilities as well as the many material blessings that are entrusted to our care. I know that each year my circumstances change. With our annual renewal process, it gives me a chance to review my own commitments of time, talent, and treasure within the parish and the larger community. I hope that you will also take this opportunity to consider how God may be calling you to renew a commitment or to consider a new way to be involved in the life of our parish family.

This past year, our focus was on how we are "A Family of Families!" We planned several events this year that were family friendly and inter-generational, including service projects. I believe it has helped us all to focus on being good stewards of our faith and prayer time.

I thank you in advance for being disciples who are good and faithful stewards and for being members of the St. Margaret Mary Family to which I belong with you. May God bless you and your family.
